

World Trade and Convention Centre Parking & Transportation Information

There is no on-site parking so what should you do? Try these handy option!:

Rainnie Drive

- Located on the eastern side of Citadel Hill.
- It is close and free! Spots fill quickly.

Scotia Square Parkade: 5201 Duke Street, Scotia Square Mall

- Rates:
Monday to Friday daytime: \$1.25 per ½ hour, daily rate of \$14.00 (6am to 6pm)
Monday to Fridays evenings: \$1.25 per ½ hour, daily rate of \$6.00 (6pm to 6am)
Lost tickets: \$16.00

MetroPark: 1556 Granville Street and 1554 Hollis Street

- Rates:
First 20 minutes: \$1.00
Each hour after (or part thereof): \$2.25
Daily rate (for up to 12 hours): \$15.00
Evening rates from 6:00 pm to 6:00 am: \$6.00

Citadel Halifax Hotel: 1960 Brunswick Street

- For guests booked using Therapeutic Recreation Association conference rate parking is complimentary. It is first come / first serve and they do not reserve spots specifically for guests.
- Daily rate of \$14.00 for the general public

Delta Halifax: 1990 Barrington Street

- \$11.25 per day for the general public

Prince George Hotel: 1725 Market Street

- \$3.00 per hour, daily rate \$20.00 for the general public
- payable by credit card only

Casino Nova Scotia: 1983 Upper Water Street

- It is possible to use pedways to walk through to the World Trade & Convention Centre
- \$2.00 per hour, daily rate of \$10 (6am – 6 pm), evening rate of \$6 (6pm – 6am)

Parking Meters

- The meters take any combination of 5¢, 10¢, 25¢, \$1.00 or \$2.00 coins (minimum 25¢ for 15 minutes).
- Maximum available time for the meter is indicated on the face of the meter. Only deposit the required coins for the maximum time on the correct meter.
- Hours of operation in the Halifax area are 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- All of the above times exclude weekends and holidays.

Wheelchair Accessible Parking

- Wheelchair accessible parking is available within a one-block radius from Halifax Metro Centre, on a first come, first served basis.
- Wheelchair accessible parking is located on:
 - Carmichael street (between Market and Brunswick streets)
 - Brunswick street (between Prince and Carmichael streets)
 - Grafton street (between Prince and Carmichael streets)
